I. Public Hearing on Proposed Administrative Rules changes

Subsection 1 of section 11-01-01-01:

- Changed to include speech-language pathology licensed assistants.

Subsection 1 b. of Section 11-02-01-01:

- Changed to specify that the official transcripts need to be received directly from the educational institute.

Subsection 2. of Section 11-02-01-01:

- changed so applications are compatible with being on the website

Subsection 6 of Section 11-02-01-01:

- This section was added to compliment changes to section 43-37-04 passed during the last legislative session.

Subsection 2 of section 11-02-01-04:

- Language was added so notifications can be sent via email

Subsection 4 of section 11-02-01-04:

- Changes clarify when a license expires and also eliminates language centering about late fees

Subsection 5 of section 11-02-01-04:

- This language was eliminated due to being condensed into subsection 4 of this section.

Subsection 6 of section 11-02-01-04:

- The language centering about “late fee” was eliminated

Subsection 7 of section 11-02-01-04:

- This language was modified for clarity centering around continuing education and re-licensure.

Subsection 9 of section 11-02-01-04:

- This language was eliminated due to being seen as a barrier to licensure.

Subsection 1 a. of section 11-02-01-08:

- Language was added for clarity and detail within the definition of “direct supervision”.

Subsection 1 b. of section 11-02-01-08:

- Language was added for clarity and detail within the definition of “indirect supervision”.

Subsection 1 c. of section 11-02-01-08:

- Language added to clarify the meaning of “clinical experience.

Subsection 1 d. of section 11-02-01-08:

- Language added to clarify the meaning of “indirect clinical experience.

Subsection 2 of section 11-02-01-08:

- Language complimenting and corresponding to changes in section 43-37-04 of the ND century code for the last legislative session.

Subsection 3. b. of section 11-02-01-08:

- Language requiring speech-language pathology licensed assistant identification to the public.

- Language clarifying tasks of a speech-language pathologist licensed assistant.

- This language clarifies requirements regarding direct supervision of a speech-language pathologist licensed assistant.

Subsection 4 h. of section 11-02-01-08:

- This language clarified circumstances centering around a speech-language pathologist supervising a speech-language pathologist licensed assistant.

Section 11-02-02-03:

- Added speech-language licensed assistants to the language

- Adding “speech-language pathology licensed assistant” so this profession is subject to the same ethical standards as speech-language pathologists and audiologists.
